	faecal coliform limit in EPA	Sampling on 27 February 2024 recorded a concentration of faecal coliforms of 280 CFU/100ml, with EPL 1770 stipulating a 200 CFU/100ml limit.	 The exceedance was reported to the NSW Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) and NSW Department of Planning and Environment (DPE). The incident was not considered to have caused material harm or loss to the environment as: Upstream sampling indicated a greater concentration of Faecal Coliform than discharge waters at CVC, downstream and outlet to creek sampling identified a lower concentration of both upstream and EPA Point 1 discharge. Sources of indicator bacteria were not considered to have been generated due to onsite operations as the sites waste water has been connected to municipal sewer since July 2023. No clean-up is or was required for the event.
